

- PEER ADVOCACY FOR GENDER EQUALITY 2019-2020

SUMMARY

The project will deal with the gender discrimination issue.

Although, Europe has made progress over recent years, current practices still favour inequality, discrimination and gender-based violence against women, so it is still necessary and crucial to guarantee their rights and giving them equal opportunities for a social and economic growth. The project aim is to tackle gender discrimination stereotypes. The schools involved are 5, from Hungary (leader), Greece (Crete), Spain, Italy, and Lithuania. The students, aged 14-16, will meet twice in Budapest and Seville where they will spend a week in a hostel together with their teachers and the students of the hosting school. During the meetings they will enhance the project themes and so coming back to their schools promote awareness raising campaigns with peer advocacy.

The project promotes European values in accordance with Article 2 of the Treaty on the European Union: "The Union is founded on the values of respect for human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law and respect for human rights, including the rights of persons belonging to minorities. These values are common to the Member States in a society in which pluralism, nondiscrimination, tolerance, justice, solidarity and equality between women and men prevail."
