Four European schools participated in the USED BUT NOT USELESS eTwinning project: Italy, France, Poland and the Czech Republic.

The project dealt with the issue of sustainability of commonly used products, wanting to show how products that we no longer use can still be reused by other people and continue to have their own life and utility. In this regard, 4 virtual shops have been created in the metaverse, where the students have uploaded some second-hand products for sale, each school has chosen a different type of products:

The students then carried out activities related to the world of work: they made researches on the most important companies in their country, they learned to write their own Curriculum Vitae, the vocabulary relating to the world of work and job application, they participated with a role-play in a job interview, they were also able to experience drafting a business plan created by the Czech school.

The Italian students met their peers from the Czech Republic via video conference and met the teachers from Poland and the Czech Republic who were invited to our school as expert teachers within the project Erasmus+ KA121.
